

Knowledge

- Learn the places and why the ice often is weaker there.
- Learn about different ice-types; "Core-Ice", "Snow-Ice, "Spring-Ice" etcetera.
- No ice is safe, but a good guideline is at least 10 cm of "Core-Ice".
- Learn how to use your personal equipment.
- Do pre-season practice.
- "Even the strongest Ice, have its weak parts".

Equipment

We always reckomend the following as basic equipment:

- Ice-prod
- Ice-spikes
- Rescue-line
- Backpack with a setup of dry clothes and food
- Waterproof case for cellphone

Remember!

The equipmet is not a vaccine for not go through the ice.



Do One Thing – to prevent drowning





Company

- Never go out on the ice without a partner that can perform a safe rescue.
- Its much touhger than it seems to do a safe rescue by your own. You will need a helping hand.
- The rescue is not finished when you stand on safe ice. Now you need to fast change to dry and warm clothes.

Its much more fun and safer to share out-door life together with friends!

What is our concern?

- Reports from different regions and users; ice-skaters, fishers, rescue-service etc, of new patterns and new kind of ice-conditions.
- Lakes and sea freezes later.
- Changing weather conditions with:
 Rapidly temperture changies, heavier snowfalls, and even rainfalls, inluence the ice-conditions

All together, it makes the ice-conditions more difficult to read and understand.

Old truths is challenged due to New Conditons.

Is the rapidly changing weather- conditions a consequence of climatechange and how can we handle it?

We need to know more.

This will be the one of future targets for the council.
